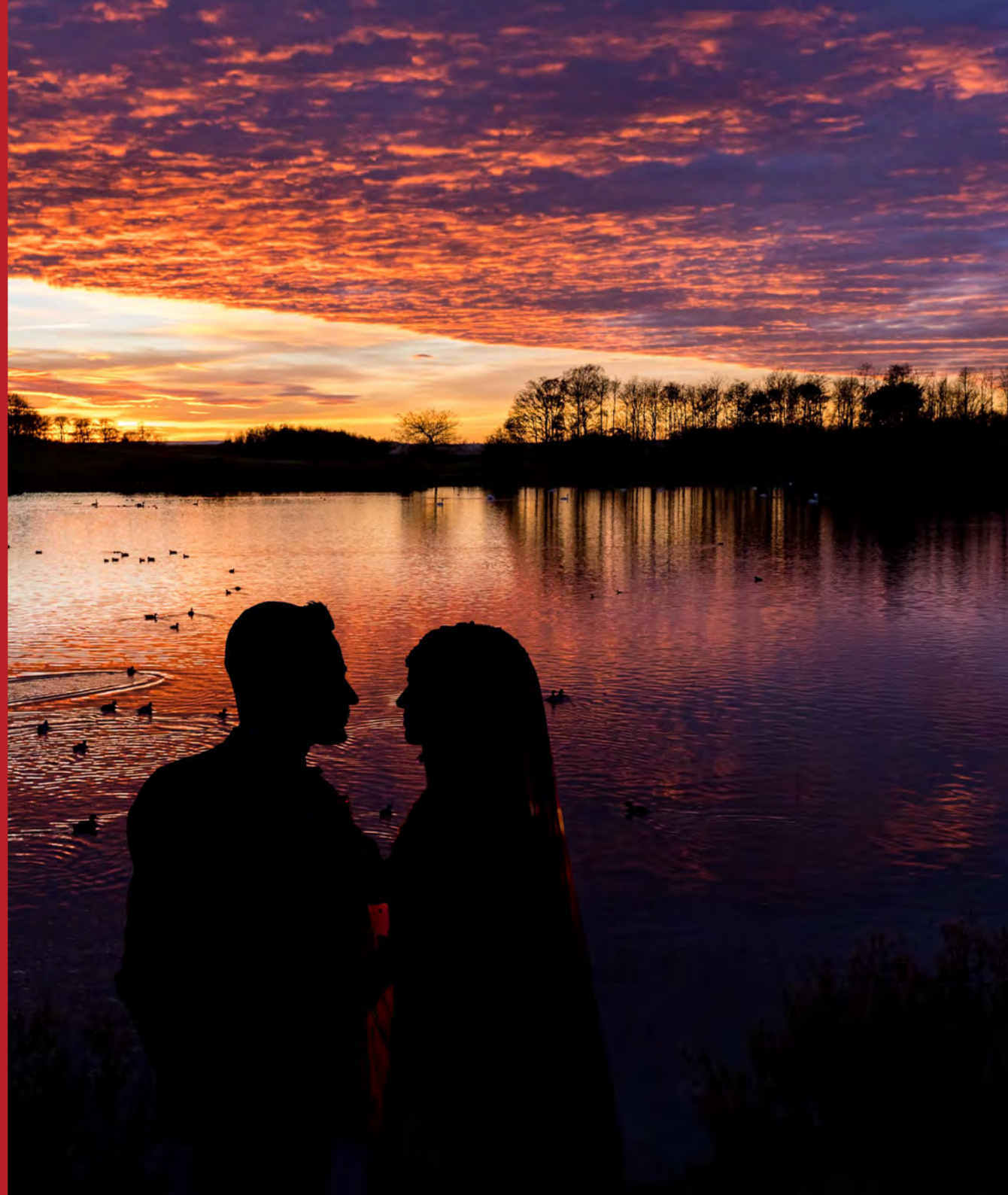
Group shots are important, but try to limit them to between 6 and 8 so you spend less time away from your guests, and more time drinking champagne.





My approach to capturing real moments applies to my portrait sessions too. Fortunately, most people are totally loved up on their wedding day, so any awkwardness disappears – even if you really hate having your picture taken. That being said, if you REALLY need some pointers on the day, I have a few tricks up my sleeve to get you to relax.

I don't just photograph weddings in Sheffield. I've also ventured to Derbyshire, Hastings, Brighton and even Spain. Nowhere is too far.

"I hate having my picture taken (makes two of us!) Will I have to pose?"

If you want any formal line ups, then yes, I guess that's posing, but otherwise, no absolutely not. I'll guide you through your portraits but I promise you it won't be posey or cringeworthy. I might even make you laugh in the process...

"Do you travel?"

Yes, all over the UK and further afield. There's normally no extra charge for travel or accommodation if I need it within the UK but if I'm out of the country we'll need to chat.

"What deposit do you require?"

I ask for a £300 deposit to secure your date. The balance is due four weeks before the wedding.

"Are you insured?"

Yes.

"Will we need to feed you on the day?"

Yes please, if I'm staying beyond when you eat, I'll need a refuel too.

"When will I receive my images?"

No later than 8 weeks after the wedding but often well before that.

"Can I order prints and products through you?"

Of course! My couples often come back to me after their wedding when they've replenished their bank accounts to buy their albums and framed images. Just because your wedding is over doesn't mean our relationship is.

Can we book you?
